Poetry Performance Guidelines for Classroom Team Competition *Begin by playing poetry roulette to find the poem that's right for you!

- 1. Each team member will select one poem for recitation from the Poetry In Voice anthology.
- 2. No notes may be used when performing.
- 3. use the Poetry In Voice tone list to identify tones and practice the tone shifts in your poem.
- 4. Take time to memorize your poem! Write it on down, sing it in the shower, say at dinner, etc.
- 5. Each member of your team will perform only once.
- 6. Poems will be judged using the Poetry In Voice scoring rubric AND the accuracy sheet.
- 7. The combined scores of the three team members will be tallied by the judges and there will be one winning team.
